RANDY J. SCHERR is President and founder of R. J. Scherr and Associates and a principal in the lobbying firm of Scherr, Winter LLC. He holds both a Bachelor and a Master of Arts Degree in Political Science. Mr. Scherr has been actively involved in the political and legislative process in Missouri on a full-time basis for 43 years and represents over 30 clients before the Missouri Legislature. THE HONORABLE ZEL M. FISCHER was appointed to the Supreme Court of Missouri October 2008 and retained by the voters in the November 2010 general election for a 12-year term expiring December 31, 2022. Prior to becoming a Judge on the Supreme Court of Missouri, Judge Fischer was a trial judge and trial lawyer in Northwest Missouri where he was born and raised and still resides today. He graduated from William Jewell College with majors in political science and philosophy, receiving the Harry S. Truman most outstanding Political Science Major, and was honored by William Jewell College with the Citation for Lifetime Achievement. He received his law degree with distinction from the University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Law. Judge Fischer is an ASTAR/NCSI Fellow,

which is a select group of judges from around the country who have special training and education to preside over complex cases involving difficult science and technology issues. Recently, Judge Fischer has been elected to be a member of the Board of Directors of the National Courts and Science Institute, which is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to training judges in Science. The NCSI Board of Directors selected him to be the President and chair of the Executive Committee. Judge Fischer is a frequent lecturer to judges and lawyers regarding the intersection of science and the law as well as constitutional issues and professional ethics. Judge Fischer is also actively involved in presenting Constitutional Forums at high schools, colleges, and universities, where he impresses upon the students the prominent importance of protecting the rights guaranteed by the Constitution.



THE HONORABLE BETH PHILLIPS is a District Court Judge for the Western District of Missouri. She was nominated by President Barack Obama. Before her judicial confirmation, Judge Phillips served as the 32nd presidentially-appointed U.S. Attorney in the Western District of Missouri, and the first woman to be appointed to the office. Judge Phillips was a trial attorney during her entire legal career, serving as Assistant Prosecutor in Jackson County, Mo., an Assistant U.S. Attorney, and in private practice, where she represented individuals in medical malpractice, nursing home negligence and product liability lawsuits. As a trial attorney, Phillips tried over 40 cases to verdict. After earning a bachelor of arts degree and a master=s degree at the University of Chicago, Judge Phillips earned her juris doctor at the University of Missouri.



THE HONORABLE ANGELA T. QUIGLESS is a judge on the Missouri Court of Appeals, Eastern District. She was appointed to this court on April, 12, 2012, by Democratic Governor Jay Nixon. She was retained in 2014 for a term that expires on December 31, 2026. Judge Quigless received her B.A. in sociology from the University of Missouri in 1981 and her J.D. from St. Louis University School of Law in 1984. Judge Quigless has worked as a trial attorney for the Missouri Department of Revenue, an assistant general counselor for the Missouri Public Service Commission, an assistant circuit attorney and city counselor for the City

of St. Louis, an assistant U.S. attorney for the Eastern District of Missouri, and a special judge for the Missouri Supreme Court. She served as a judge of the 22nd Circuit Court from 2003 until 2012, when she joined the appellate court.



THE HONORABLE JASON R. BROWN assumed the position of associate circuit judge for the 31st Judicial Circuit on January 1, 2005. He was then elected to office by Greene County voters in 2006 and retained in 2010. He received a bachelor's degree from the University of Missouri, with honors, in 1985, and graduated from Vanderbilt University School of Law in 1988. He served in private practice for 16 years prior to taking the bench in 2005. Judge Brown was appointed Circuit Judge in July 2015, retained in 2016 and served since then. Judge Brown has served on the Greene County Teen Court as a volunteer judge; State Courts Administrator Traffic Bench Guide Editor in 2010 and 2013; as a board member with the Missouri Association of Probate and Associate Judges; and is on the 31st Judicial Circuit

Pretrial Release Committee. He is also a board member of the Good Samaritan Boys Ranch and is a member of Springfield Southeast Rotary, where he has held the position of sergeant at arms for 2013-2014. He is Chair of the Missouri Supreme Court's Civic Education Committee and serves on the Trial Judge Education Committee.



THE HONORABLE WILLIAM P. DEVOY was appointed Associate Circuit Judge on December 1, 2020 by Governor Michael Parson. Judge Devoy received his Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration from Rockhurst College (now University) in 1990. He then attended the University of Missouri -Columbia School of Law receiving his Juris Doctor in 1994. Upon graduating from law school, he ran for and was elected Prosecuting Attorney of Linn County. He served in that capacity from January 1, 1995 - December 31, 1999. During and after his time as prosecutor Judge Devoy worked in private practice in both Brookfield and Columbia for more than 25 years. As an attorney

Judge Devoy's practice was general in nature with areas of greater focus including real estate, estate planning, estate administration and healthcare compliance. The many juvenile court cases in which he served as Guardian Ad Litem provided his most rewarding, and sometimes most frustrating, work in private practice. Judge Devoy is married to Annie Miller Devoy and they have two sons.





MICHAEL DOWNEY is a legal ethics lawyer and founder of Downey Law Group LLC, a St. Louis law firm devoted to legal ethics, lawyer discipline defense, and the law of lawyering. Michael has litigated dozens of lawyer discipline cases and argued before five appellate courts. He has also testified as an expert in more than twenty proceedings. In addition to his law practice, Michael has taught legal ethics and law firm practice at Washington University School of Law since 2003. He chaired the ABA Law Practice Division from 2013-14; has presented on legal ethics more than 600 times; and has published the book *Introduction to Law Firm Practice* (ABA 2010) and more than 180 articles on legal ethics, including the "Ethox and

Paradox" columns for the ABA's *Litigation* magazine. *Super Lawyers* has recognized Michael a top 50 lawyer in St. Louis and top 100 lawyer in Missouri and Kansas. *Missouri Lawyers Weekly* has named Michael a 2014 Most Influential Lawyer as the "go-to legal ethics lawyer in Missouri" and awarded his firm two innovation awards.
